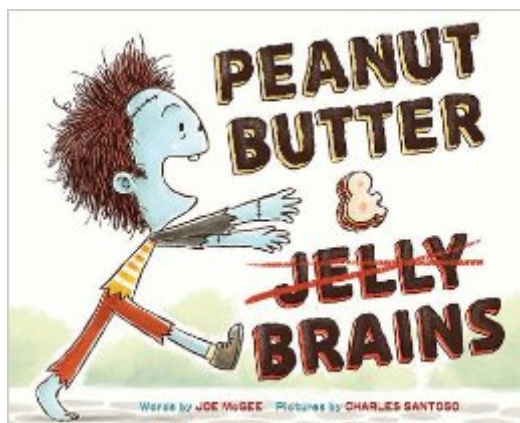

The townspeople of course are thrilled with this new turn of events and embrace the zombies into their every day life and Reginald moves onto a new favorite food but you'll have to read the book to find out what it is! This fun twist makes zombies kid-friendly and relatable.
