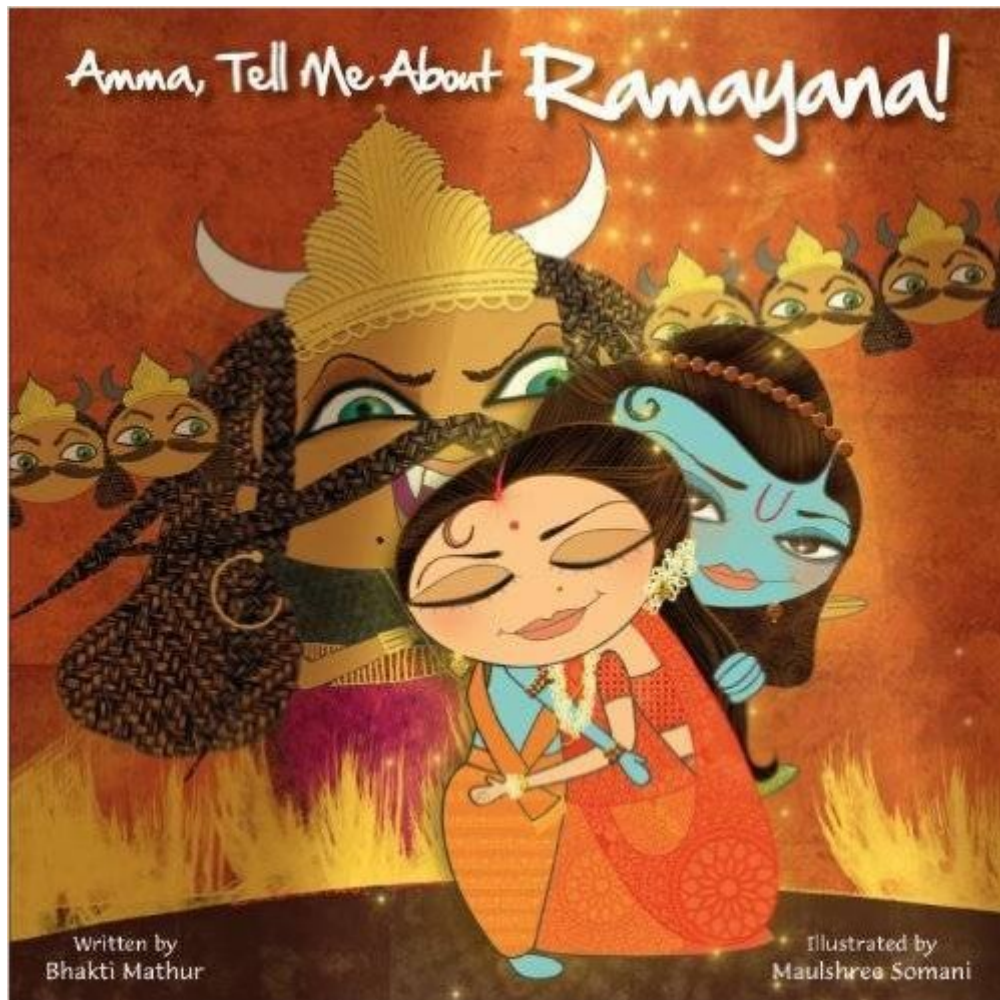

The story has been abridged a little too much. I bought it for my 6 yr old. It is good as an introduction to Ramayana. I am now reading him the Amar Chitra Katha version...which a little too detailed for him. He is able to relate to the Amma Tell Me About version as I read the detailed one. I wish there was something in between.

When is a story a song? When it is a riot of colour called `Amma, Tell Me About Ramayana!' It is a beautifully written book in simple lyrical language. The characters of Rama, Sita and Hanuman jump out beautifully. Reading it brought back childhood memories for me. I would recommend this to every parent, grandparent, teacher, even uncles who care.
